

Admission to the Pool

Membership dues must be paid in full prior to using the pool for the first time. Members must show identification and sign in at the gate. Children fourteen (14) years and younger may only be in the pool enclosure with adult supervision. Children fifteen (15) and older that demonstrate swimming skills may be left unsupervised WITH WRITTEN PERMISSION. A permission form must also be completed for non-member guests and signed by that child's parent or guardian. A child must be able to jump into the 5-foot end and swim to the rope without stopping or touching the side of the pool.

Membership Categories

Family: Three or more people *living in the same household* (two adults max per membership).

Two Person Families: Two adults or an adult and one child *living in the same household*.

Single Adult: One person membership

Guests

Members may bring guests to the pool with the use of guest passes. Each guest can come to the pool a **maximum of 5 times**. Members must accompany their guests at all times and are responsible for their conduct.

Members may purchase individual guest passes at the snack bar, or a sheet of ten (10) at a discounted fee. Members must show their Membership ID to purchase guest passes. Guest Passes are not required for children UNDER two years old or adults in non-swimming attire. Guest passes CANNOT be replaced, are only good for the year in which it is purchased, and are NOT refundable if the pool closes due to inclement weather.

Babysitters

Babysitters must be 15 years or older. Members that employ a non-member babysitter may purchase a sitter's pass for the season. A member babysitting a non-member may purchase a pass for the non-member child. These are restricted passes and *may only be used when accompanied by the member*.

Swim Lessons

Group and individual swim lessons are available from certified instructors for children and adults. Swimming lesson dates and times will be located on the bulletin board near the front gate. **Children may not enter the adult pool area until the lesson begins AND the instructor is present.**

Swim Team

Member children may join the CRA Dolphins at any time during the swim team season. There is an annual registration fee. Practices are Monday through Friday. Children are encouraged to attend as many practices and meets as possible. *All parents must volunteer to help during home swim meets.* Swim team members are strongly encouraged to participate in a fund raising activity to help offset the costs of the team. Swim team members **may only enter the competition pool area when the coaches are present.**

Adult Swim

Adult swim will be called each hour in the L-Pool for no longer than ten minutes; only adults 18 or older may be in the pool. Parents may not bring infants/toddlers in the pool. The lap pool/competition pool is for adult use only. At least one lane in the adult pool will remain open for adults during swim team practice. **No person under the age of 18 may enter the gates to the adult pool** unless it is for swim team purpose, supervised by the coach(es).

After Hours Pool Party

All parties must be over by 11:00 pm since we are in a residential area. A deposit is required and is refunded if the area is cleaned up to the satisfaction of pool staff. There is a minimum hourly fee to pay two lifeguards; an additional hourly fee applies for each additional lifeguard for parties with more than 50 swimmers (one lifeguard for every additional 25 swimmers).

Children's Birthday Pool Parties

Have your party at the pool! Birthday Party Packages are available. This service is available to members and their guests only! Limit 12 children per party. Parties include menu choices from the Snack Bar, Goody Bags, Table Reservations, and Clean Up. You can relax and have fun because we will do all the work for you. Parties need to be booked at least one week in advance. More information about parties can be found in the snack bar or by contacting the pool manager at 264-8119.

Picnic Shelter Rental

The picnic shelter may be rented by members and non-members. Glass bottles are not permitted. A deposit is required and will be refunded if the area is cleaned up to the satisfaction of pool staff.

Lessons, parties, pool or shelter rentals are also available for non-members

Pool Rules

The operation of the pools and enforcement of the rules is under the direction of pool staff. Disciplinary action for minor infractions may include sitting out of the pool. More serious offenses may result in suspension of membership privileges: one day for a first offense; up to seven days for a second offense.

1. Obey lifeguards at all times.
2. The **lap/competition pool** is **restricted to supervised** swim team and swim lesson use, and **adults** 18 years of age or older. **CHILDREN MAY NOT PASS THROUGH THE GATES** unless a coach or swim instructor is present.
3. **Parents must be in the pool with children who are non-swimmers** wearing waist or arm flotation devices. US Coast Guard approved life vests are preferred and available upon request.
4. **Members must leave the pool enclosure area when thunder or lightning is seen OR heard.** Lifeguards will allow members to return 30 minutes after the last instance.
5. The kiddie pool is only for small children up to age six (6), **supervised by an adult present within its fenced area.**
6. Diving is allowed in designated areas ONLY
7. No running, horseplay, pushing, dunking, or foul language.
8. Only proper swimming attire allowed.
9. Approved eye goggles are allowed, but may not be used while diving or jumping off the diving board. Facemasks, snorkels and fins are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguards.
10. Balls, toys, water guns, diving or play objects are allowed in the pool at the discretion of the lifeguards.
11. Spitting, spouting water, eating food, or blowing noses is forbidden in the pools.
12. No glass containers of any kind are allowed within the pool enclosure.
13. Smoking is not allowed except in designated areas by the adult pool.
14. Lifeguards may exclude anyone from the deep water who has not demonstrated sufficient ability to swim.
15. Cross-pool games may be played with ten (10) or less swimmers at the discretion of the lifeguards. No running dives allowed.
16. Only lifeguards are allowed on the lifeguard stands.
17. Parents are to remind their children of the importance of using the toilet facilities. Children who are not toilet trained must wear "swimmies." If a sanitary accident occurs, the pool will close for cleaning and may take several hours.
18. Toys on wheels (vehicles, wagons, big wheels, etc.) are not allowed inside the pool enclosures. Go-karts, motorized bikes, skates, roller blades, skateboards, etc. are forbidden on the grounds, including the parking lot.

Please be aware that any unauthorized presence on association property, or the use of the facilities during non-operating hours, constitutes trespassing. The Henrico County police have been authorized to apprehend and prosecute any trespassers.
